### Warner Library has a new system!

In a long overdue move, Warner Library has migrated to a new integrated library system (ILS). The Library will now use EBSCO's FOLIO software in order to check out books, catalog items, track usage statistics and more. For our patrons, this means a new local catalog interface and some updates to our circulation policies. We will <u>upload updated tutorial videos to our website</u> throughout the summer, but below is a basic summary of the changes now live at the library.



New circulation rules are now in place for books—see the table to the right. Also, the limit on media items has been raised to 10 per person.

Graduate and Doctoral Students	Full semester, limit of 50 books, no renewals
Faculty and Staff	90 days, unlimited books, 1 renewal
