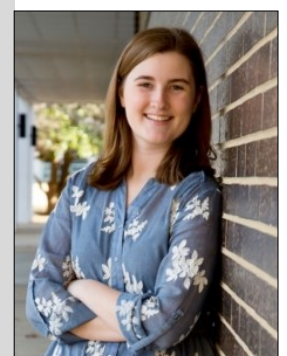

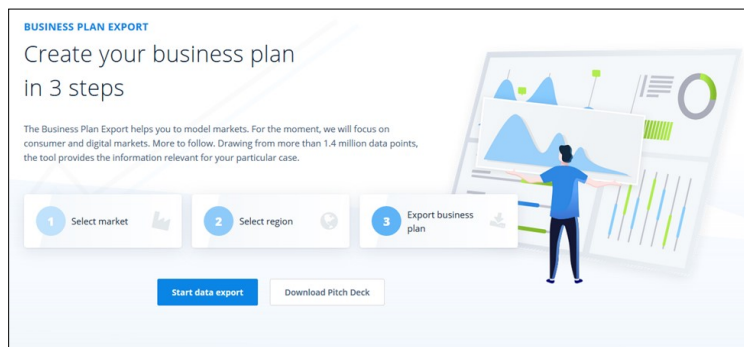

Statista gets an upgrade

One of Warner Library's subscribed databases, Statista, was recently updated and now has a multitude of new features. Below is a quick run-down of what you can expect to find new and improved in the database.

- **Dossierplus** reports, available for download on a multitude of topics, such as mobility services or luxury tourism, containing timelines, editorial content, infographics and more.
- **Global Consumer Survey**, gathering data on more than 400,000 consumers in 46 countries and over 50 industries to help researchers understand consumer behavior on a global scale.
- **Historical data**, including NASA reports, battle statistics, and population data will be added, covering dates from the 1600s to the 1800s.
- **Country Outlook**, giving predictive data on the economic and social aspects of various countries and is completely searchable by country and subject.
- **Business Plan Export Tool**, which combines consumer and digital market reports and predicts business trends for whatever business you decide to hypothetically create, based off market and region.
- **Company Database**, comparing the revenue, number of employees and country of over 40,000 companies, allowing you to compare companies such as Coca-Cola, Hershey, and more.
