Oxford English Dictionary added to databases!

Due to popular demand, Warner Library has subscribed to the Oxford English Dictionary online!

The OED is the premier historical English Dictionary, containing over 1,000 years of the English language, more than 500,000 entries and 3.5 million quotations. Every entry contains factsheets for the word, including historical use, etymology, pronunciation and various examples on how to use the word within its meanings.

The OED also introduced a new website layout last year which improved site functionality and enhanced accessibility compliance, making it easier than ever to search the dictionary.
