
New Ebooks and Audiobooks in OverDrive—Requested by YOU!


Late September 2023, the library held a survey amongst the Eastern student body, asking about the kinds of leisure reading ebooks and audiobooks they'd like to see added to the digital collection. Well, the results are in, and the library has purchased **43 ebooks** and **18 audiobooks in OverDrive** based off of your suggestions!

Overwhelmingly, the types of ebooks most requested were young adult fiction and self-help and self-improvement titles. We also received a number of requests for romance, fantasy and mystery novels, as well as specific young adult series. Most students were interested in having ebooks only, but a majority wanted both formats; our audiobook selection was determined by popularity, award winners and famous or talented narrators.





The spring semester will start soon, and we want to be sure faculty have the resources necessary to ensure student




success. This means now is the time to <u>request</u> <u>library instruction</u> with one of our librarians.


