## New Database added: Ethnic Diversity Source

In an effort to obtain resources attuned to the diverse needs of our community, Warner Library has subscribed to the [Ethnic Diversity Source](#) collection. Created by Ebsco in 2021, Ethnic Diversity Source “give(s) researchers a dedicated resource covering the culture, traditions, social treatment and lived experiences of different ethnic groups in America.”



Ethnic Diversity Source is a robust resource for diversity and ethnic studies that stands out for its rich array of books, journals, newspapers, primary sources, and other materials.”

Approximately 500 full-text journals, magazines, and newspapers can be found within the collection, more than 350 of which are peer-reviewed. There’s also over 5,000 e-books, 2,000 biographies, and 1,000 streaming videos, curated from the Associated Press. The pride of the collection, however, is in the tens of thousands of historical documents, including speeches, interviews, and letters from diverse populations. These populations include everyone from African, Arab, and Latinx Americans to Native, Jewish, and Asian Americans (and everyone in-between!)

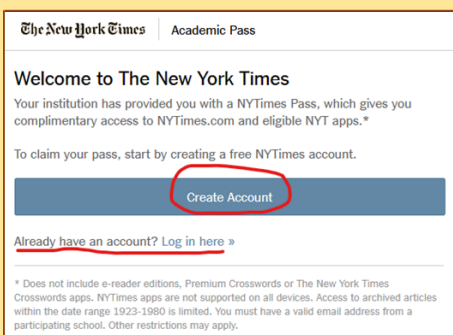
